All the services provided, facilities available and vehicles used are outlined in these sections. In addition to the price, this section includes a detailed description of the services, facilities and vehicles we offer.

Additional Services or Supplies

This section discusses additional services and/or supplies that might apply to the ceremony type selected. The additions may include such items as pacemaker removal, storage fees, ceremony stationery, cemetery equipment and reception facilities. In regards to the reception facilities we offer for receptions following ceremonies, the maximum number we are able to accommodate being 150 people. Also certain scheduling restrictions may apply. We are pleased to make arrangements with a caterer for you.

Cash Disbursements

You may wish to have us arrange for goods and services in addition to those which we provide. Such items, paid for by us on your behalf, would appear on our account as cash disbursements. This section provides a list of some of the items we are frequently called upon to obtain. The prices associated with these items vary considerably, however where possible the price or range of prices is indicated.

Caskets, Containers, Vaults and Urns

This section includes a description and the price of each casket, container, urn and vault we offer.

Ceremony Types

We are called upon to arrange many different types of services. The 16 different types we most frequently provide are identified in this section. If, however, the type of service that would best suit your wishes or the wishes of your family is not listed, we are able to customize the funeral arrangements to suit your requirements. -Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs. A Basic Consultation fee is payable whenever we provide services to you.		
Documentation – permits, forms, etc.	\$	690
-Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner’s certificate for cremation, documentation necessary to ship the body out of the country -Provision of 12 Proofs of Death issued by MacCoubrey Funeral Home Ltd. (our proofs of death are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial “Death Certificate” will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General)		
Co-ordinating activities, rites, ceremonies	\$	465
-Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including, but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs regarding rites, ceremonies and activities -Co-ordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as flowers and death notices.		
Transfer remains from place of death (within 20 km; additional fees apply beyond 20 km,)	\$	160
-Transportation of the remains from one place to another, for example the hospital to the funeral home, a charge applies for each transportation request		
Transfer remains to cemetery or crematorium (within 20 km; additional fees apply beyond 20 km,)	\$	115
-Transportation of the remains from one place to another, for example the funeral home to the cemetery or crematorium, a charge applies for each transportation request.		
Basic preparation of remains (requires Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter)	\$	190
-The preparation of the body for placement into the casket or container, including bathing, dressing and the setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming.		
Embalming of remains (requires Basic preparation of remains)	\$	520
-Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.

An additional fee which reflects the increased staff required to set-up at a location outside of the funeral home.

Transfer Van	\$	120
Vehicle used for transfer of the deceased from the place of death to the funeral home and from the funeral home to either the cemetery or crematorium when the use of the hearse is not included.		
General Duties Vehicle	\$	105
The use of this car may include any or all of the following: collection of cremated remains, procuring documentation, delivering documentation, delivering flowers, transportation of clergy to the funeral home, cemetery, or crematorium, leading the funeral procession.		
Hearse	\$	380
The use of this specialized vehicle includes the transportation of the deceased from the funeral home to the cemetery or crematorium, or from the funeral home to the church or other remote location of the funeral and to the cemetery or crematorium.		
Mileage	\$	4.00
A charge per km of one way travel applies to any of the vehicles listed for mileage incurred beyond a 20 km radius of the funeral home.

PAYMENT

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment must be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards. Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets. Financing charges apply to payment plans. Beyond the allotted time interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5%, which is equivalent to 18 % per annum.

FINANCING

Our payment plans give you the option of making payments over time. We offer a competitive financing program, administrative fees and interest rates.

FUNDING

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust

You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance

You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is cancelled.
