In regards to the reception facilities we offer for receptions following ceremonies, the maximum number we are able to accommodate being 150 people. Also certain scheduling restrictions may apply. We are pleased to make arrangements with a caterer for you.

Cash Disbursements

You may wish to have us arrange for goods and services in addition to those which we provide. Such items, paid for by us on your behalf, would appear on our account as cash disbursements. This section provides a list of some of the items we are frequently called upon to obtain. PAYMENT

Unless otherwise specified or agreed upon, disbursements and taxes listed in the contract must be paid at the time of arrangement.

Payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment must be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards. Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets. Financing charges apply to payment plans. Beyond the allotted time interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5%, which is equivalent to 18 % per annum.

FINANCING

Our payment plans give you the option of making payments over time. We offer a competitive financing program, administrative fees and interest rates.

FUNDING

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.
